- Spurs must beat Rennes to have any chance of qualifying for knockout stages You have to hand it to Tottenham. This was a night to suck the zest from any manager. Even one with the boundless zeal and passion of Antonio Conte. It took them all of three weeks.

'I am starting to understand the situation - it is not simple. At this moment the level at Tottenham is not so high,' Conte admitted after this humiliation.

'I am happy to stay here but we have to work a lot to improve the quality of the squad. We are Tottenham but there is an important gap with the top teams. I am not scared.'

Maybe not. But Conte is not naïve either. He will have seen how, with every road trip in the Europa Conference League, Spurs break new ground. How with every foreign adventure, the rap sheet grows for their second-string. How with every visit to a backwater of continental football, their capacity for charity knows no bounds.

The concern for Conte? After handing out famous wins to Pacos de Ferreira and Vitesse Arnhem, this embarrassment tops the lot. NS Mura. A club only founded in 2012, a team whose ground was deemed unfit to host this game. A side without a point in Europe's third-rate competition before Thursday night. Statistically the worst side in the whole thing - comparable in quality to Accrington Stanley, apparently.

So for them, Amadej Marosa's goal – with the last kick of this game – secured an unforgettable triumph.

As for the bubble of optimism that greeted Conte's arrival in north London?

'I am not a magician and after three weeks I have found players that want to work and have great commitment but sometimes it is not enough,' he said.

'I want to be very honest, we have to work a lot and improve in many, many aspects. We have to do better at many, many things. It is important in football to have vision. Where are you now and what do you want in the future.'

He added: 'We have to do better in everything, everything,' Here's hoping that message gets through to Dele Alli, Bryan Gil and the other fringe players who wasted this first chance to impress.

No one did their cause more harm than Davinson Sanchez and Ryan Sessegnon.

The wingback was sent off after 31 minutes on his first start since August; Sanchez giftwrapped both Mura goals. First, on 11 minutes, he allowed Tomi Horvat to cut inside and curl Mura in front.

And then, deep into stoppage time, he allowed Marosa to cut inside before deflecting the ball past Pierluigi Gollini in his own goal. He was nothing if not consistent.

It's nights like this that make you sympathise with Nuno Espirito Santo and his two-tier squad.

Certainly Conte will know more about his best team after this. Spurs now head into their final Group G game knowing, realistically, only victory over Rennes will keep alive their hopes of progression.

Mura weren't even formed the last time Tottenham tasted silverware. Now they may have cost Conte his best chance of ending that drought. Earlier, the Italian almost spared his side's blushes with a quadruple substitution that stirred Spurs to life in the second half.

Lucas Moura, one of those replacements, found Harry Kane – one of two survivors from victory over Leeds – who cancelled out Horvat's opener. But then, deep into stoppage time, Ben Davies slipped and, Marosa was set free to score.

A point would have been the most Tottenham deserved.

Until those changes, Conte's side were disjointed, careless and scratchy across the pitch. Just like the old days under Nuno then.

But the arrival of Eric Dier, Son Heung-min, Lucas and Ben Davies made a difference. Son's driving run ended with his shot palmed over. Kane sent a free header straight down the throat of Matko Obradovic. With 18 minutes left, they did level thanks to Kane's chip over Obradovic from a tight angle.

He could have won it in the final 10 minutes, but the striker couldn't crane his neck enough to divert a header on target. And so it was left to Marosa to pile on the misery.



But the evening ended in calamity for Conte's side who now must beat Rennes in two weeks
